



Judith A. Calogero has served as Commissioner of the New York State Division of Housing and Community Renewal (DHCR) since 2002. Commissioner Calogero is a housing professional with more than 24 years of experience. She previously served as Deputy Commissioner of DHCR's Office of Community Development since 1995. In that capacity, she administered programs that provided financing for the development of more than 4,000 units of affordable housing each year. Ms. Calogero started her career in a DHCR-sponsored neighborhood preservation company (NPC), and served as the executive director of both an NPC and the Rural Housing Coalition. Ms. Calogero also serves as chair of the Housing Trust Fund Corporation, chair and CEO of the Roosevelt Island Operating Corporation, and is a member of the Board of Directors of the NYS Housing Finance Agency and the NYS Mortgage Agency, the NYS Affordable Housing Corporation, the NY Mortgage Loan and Enforcement Agency, the NYS Project Finance Agency, the Homeless Housing and Assistance Corporation, and the Harlem Community Development Corporation. Recently, Governor Pataki has named her chair of the Advisory Task Force on Housing for Persons with Special Needs. Ms. Calogero is a member of the Most Integrated Setting Coordinating Council. Ms. Calogero has a Bachelor's degree from the College of Saint Rose and a Master's degree in Urban and Environmental Studies from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute.
