



**Sarah Gerecke** is Chief Executive Officer of Neighborhood Housing Services (NHS) of NYC, where she oversees lending, education, community development and real estate programs that resulted in \$217 million invested in underserved communities in 2005. She joined NHS as Chief Operating Officer in 2001.
