



Robin Snyderman became Housing Director at the Metropolitan Planning Council in 1998. In 2002, she staffed the Transition Team Housing Committee for Governor Rod Blagojevich and is currently serving on the Executive Committee of the Governor's Housing Task Force, for which she also chaired its Regional Solutions Committee. Ms. Snyderman began her professional career in housing in San Francisco in 1989, initially as the tenant coordinator and then the property manager of the first supportive housing community developed by the nonprofit Mission Housing Development Corporation (MHDC). Ms. Snyderman then moved to MHDC's main office and formed the corporation's supportive housing program. The success of these efforts prompted her appointment to numerous planning and policy initiatives in San Francisco. Ms. Snyderman is currently Chair of the City of Evanston's Housing Commission, a Board Member of the Illinois Housing Council and Interfaith Council for the Homeless, a Trustee of the National Housing Conference and a Fellow of Leadership Greater Chicago.
